

Tabitop Privacy Policy

Effective February 24, 2014

Tabitop's Privacy Policy describes how we collect, use and handle your information and data when you use our websites, software, services, subscriptions, and virtual desktop connectivity ("Services").

Tabitop collects and uses the following information to provide, improve and protect our Services:

Services. When you use our Services, we store, process and transmit virtual desktop data (including but not limited to like your username, password, email address, etc.) and information related to them, for example when and where you connected to the Services. If you give us access to your contacts, Tabitop will store those contacts on our servers for you to use. This will make it easy for you to share desktop access, subscription, send emails, and invite others to use the Services.

Account. We collect, and associate with your account, information like your name, Tabitop Account ID, email address, phone number, payment information, and physical address. Some of our Services let you access your accounts and your information with other service providers. We additionally may send your Account information or portions of your Account information to our trusted third-party providers, only for the use of offering your specific Services, for example, sending your Account ID information to third-party providers required to provide you Services. Tabitop will never send any data to third-party providers or partners for marketing, data sharing, or other non-related activities that do not provide a component or portion of the direct Services.

Usage. We collect information from and about the devices you use to access the Services. This includes things like IP addresses, the type of browser and device you use, the web page you visited before coming to our sites, and identifiers associated with your devices. Your devices (depending on their settings) may also transmit location information to the Services.

Tabitop uses Cookies and other technologies. Cookies are small data files sent to your browser when you visit a site. We use cookies and pixel tags to provide, protect, and increase the promotion of our Services. Cookies log you into our Services, remember preferences and settings, keep your account secure, and better understand how people are using our services in order to improve our Services to the best of their abilities.

A pixel tag ("pixel") is a small piece of code that can be embedded on websites

and emails. Tabitop uses pixels to learn how you interact with our webpages and emails. This information helps us tailor and promote our services. For example, if you visit one of our Tabitop Desktop pages, you may later see an ad for Tabitop Desktop when you visit a tech news site.

Most browsers allow you to delete cookies and prevent them from being set again in the future. Note that some of our features may not work correctly without cookies enabled.

If our systems receive a DNT:1 signal from your browser, we'll stop using pixels to promote our services on third-party sites accessed via that browser. You can set your browser to not accept cookies, but this may limit your ability to use the Services.

Data Sharing

Tabitop may share information with certain third-party vendors, partners, and affiliates as described below, but won't sell it to advertisers or other third-parties not associated with providing components of the Services.

Others working for Tabitop. Tabitop uses certain trusted third parties to help us provide, improve, protect, and promote our Services. These third parties will access your information only to perform tasks on our behalf and in compliance with this Privacy Policy.

Other applications. You can also give third parties access to your information and account - for example, via Tabitop API. Any third-party connection through the Tabitop API will be governed by their privacy policies and terms.

Law & Order. We may disclose your information to third parties if we determine that such disclosure is reasonably necessary to (a) comply with the law; (b) protect any person from death or serious bodily injury; (c) prevent fraud or abuse of Tabitop or our users; or (d) protect Tabitop's property rights.

Stewardship of your data is critical to us and a responsibility that we embrace. We believe that our users' data should receive the same legal protections regardless of whether it's stored on our services or on their home computer's hard drive. We'll abide by the following generally accepted Government Request Principles when receiving, scrutinizing and responding to government requests for our users' data by the following:

- Be transparent,
- Fight blanket requests,
- Protect all users, and
- Provide trusted services.

Security

Security. We have a team dedicated to keeping your information secure and testing for vulnerabilities. We also continue to work on features to keep your information safe in addition to things like two-factor authentication, encryption of virtual desktop instances.

Retention. We'll retain information you store on our Services for as long as we need it to provide you the Services. Please note: (1) there might be some latency in deleting this information from our servers and back-up storage; and (2) we may retain this information if necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, or enforce our agreements.

Around the world. To provide you with the Services, we may store, process and transmit information in locations around the world - including those outside your country. Information may also be stored locally on the devices you use to access the Services.

Safe Harbor. Tabitop complies with the EU-U.S. and Swiss-U.S. Safe Harbor ("Safe Harbor") frameworks and principles. You can learn more about Safe Harbor by visiting <http://export.gov/safeharbor>. TRUSTe is the independent organization responsible for reviewing and resolving complaints about our Safe Harbor compliance. Changes/Updates

If we are involved in a reorganization, merger, acquisition or sale of our assets, your information may be transferred as part of that deal. We will notify you (for example, via a message to the email address associated with your account) of any such deal and outline your choices in that event.

We may revise this Privacy Policy from time to time, and will post the most current version on our website. If a revision meaningfully reduces your rights, we will notify you.
